### TO MATRICULATE

A cumulative grade point average of 2.0 is required. Students who are not enrolled in a specific program are non-matriculated. To apply for matriculation enter desired curriculum code in box (see codes at bottom). Academic transcripts may be required for certain curriculums.

## TRANSFER CREDIT POLICY

To receive transfer credit from other accredited colleges, CLEP (College Level Examination Program) or AP (Advance Placement), official transcripts must be on file in the Admissions Office. For many majors, high school transcripts, GED certificate or college transcripts may not be required, but the statement confirming high school graduation is required. All Allied Health, Nursing School and International Students must submit high school and college transcripts. Advanced Standing credit is granted for courses which correspond in subject matter to courses offered at Union County College. Only courses that apply to the major are transferred in. A student may transfer up to 32 credit hours to Union County College from another institution. Students who have previously been awarded a Bachelor's Degree may receive up to 40 transfer redit hours to wards an unrelated Associate Degree Program. Students entering one of the cooperative nursing programs at Union County College may be granted up to 22 college credits of advanced standing toward the Associates Degree (MHBN may receive 32 effective Spring 2000). Nursing school courses completed prior to admission are evaluated by the nursing school. <u>Courses with grades lower than "C" will not be accepted</u>. Acceptable grade may vary per program requirement. Credit courses accepted from another institution will not be considered in computing the grade point average at Union County College. It is the student's responsibility to supply the college with the official transcripts of all previous college work and to request an evaluation.

(All Science and Computer Courses must be less than 10 years old from the acceptance and enrollment in program. (MHBN transfer requirements may differ).
